Church Heating As you will be aware, we are looking at replacing the gas heaters in the summer of 2026. However, several heaters have been condemned as they leak "noxious gas". We are now having to expedite the project to enable the church to be warm. The project will cost about £54,000 UPDATE. Planning permission has been applied for and progressing through the system. Please see the display in the foyer for all the details.

Fund Raising In order to pay for the new heating system, a fund raising group is being set up. Several people have expressed interest and are discussing ideas.
